
- Student migration


European comparisons: Proportion of foreign born population






Growing ethnic diversity


Multi and Interdisciplinary:

Aim: using drama and role play, to develop a research-based, pedagogical model for effective interpreting in intercultural healthcare settings.



Learning from practitioners interpreters and service users









Research design: 3 stages

Stage 1: Review of theory, method, policy and practice into interpreted-mediated health care encounters

- Overwhelmingly single perspectives represented
- Clinical settings dominate
- Focus on language barriers













Stage 2: Qualitative Interviews

- Health care practitioners (midwives, health visitors and sexual health specialists)
- Interpreters (French. Arabic, Urdu, Polish, Slovakian)
- Service users (asylum seekers, refugees, migrant workers)

Stage 3: Developed into 5 short educational films

5 Short Films (online/DVD) & Learning Materials




