## Self-referral to Occupational Health

Since May 2014 you are no longer able to refer yourself to Occupational Health.

If you wish to meet with Occupational Health to discuss a work-related health issue, you will need to ask your line manager to make a referral via the paperwork which can be found via <u>Information for Managers</u>.

If your line manager is part of the problem which you feel necessitates your referral, please approach your College/University Service or Human Resources Manager who can refer you instead.

Our Employee Assistance Programme, PAM Assist, is of course available 24 hours a day to assist you with personal support for health and wellbeing.

Your GP will also help with any specific health worries that you may have.
