

# ALLEGATION OF MISCONDUCT IN AN EXAMINATION

Misconduct in an Examination (on campus – see also process for plagiarism/collusion allegations in online exams)

Is this the first allegation against you?

You will normally be interviewed by **two Senate Assessors** for Student Conduct, or have your case considered in your absence

If they find you have not breached the Code of Student Conduct, no penalty will be applied

**The matter is closed**

A penalty may be applied. The outcome will be reported to your School/others as necessary

**Your case is concluded**

In very severe or complex cases, your case might be referred to **Senate Student Academic Conduct Committee**

Is this a repeat allegation?

You may be interviewed by the **Senate Student Academic Conduct Committee**

A penalty may be applied. The outcome will be reported to your School/others as necessary

**Your case is concluded**

If they find you have not breached the Code, no penalty will be applied

**The matter is closed**

You can **APPEAL** against the outcome, to the **Senate Student Conduct Appeal Committee**

Appeal Committee

Appeal dismissed

Appeal upheld

**Your case is concluded**

You can complain to the **Scottish Public Services Ombudsman** if you are not satisfied
