Project Update

Experts by Experience, NSPCC practitioners, Local Authorities and the research team came together at Development Days in September and December. Our Working Groups on Poverty Awareness, Neurodiversity and Intervention and Assessment have developed and delivered their workstreams to ensure the development of a holistic system of support to be delivered to families.

Through a process of Coproduction, we have developed a new intervention, Infant Parent Support (IPS) for use in the trial. Referral Pathways and detailed Trial recruitment criteria for IPS have also now been established.

Our Trial Steering Committee met for the first time in November. Professor Geraldine Macdonald (Chair), Mr Dean Grainger and Dr Pallab Majumder will have oversight of the work of the Trial. We welcome their expertise and insights. We have continued to work closely with our funder, What Works for Children's Social Care, to implement a robust governance framework for the Trial.

As we move into the spring, we are looking forward to progressing into the 'live' phase of the Trial and starting to recruit families.

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
