

Dr Kimberly Marsh currently leads the Viral Pathogens Team at Public Health Scotland. She joined PHS five years ago as the head of the COVID-19 Real-Time Epidemiology Team. Kim also holds a senior scientific adviser role within the Scottish Pandemic Sciences Partnership. Her work focuses on national surveillance of viral and respiratory infectious diseases, winter preparedness and response, and outbreak investigation. She leads the generation and communication of evidence to inform public health action, including vaccine effectiveness and risk assessment. She works closely with Health Boards, laboratories and policy colleagues to support Scotland's infectious disease intelligence and response functions. Kim holds a PhD in Infectious Disease Epidemiology from Imperial College London and a Masters in Health Sciences from Johns Hopkins University. Prior to joining Public Health Scotland, Kim worked for over 20 years on the HIV/AIDS response at UNAIDS and the US Centres for Disease Control and Prevention.
