## **2026-27 Year 3 Systems Block– Remote Telephone Consultation Workshops Commencing February 2027**

All Year 3 students rotate through four 5-week blocks (new Systems Block, Medicine, Surgery and their Student Selected Component), with each block being delivered 4 times for the whole cohort.

The Year 3 Systems block is designed to consolidate learning across systems of care and a greater understanding of the patient journey through these systems. The Year 3 GP teaching team are delighted to be able to build on the existing community-based curriculum and experiences by delivering a variety of GP teaching components within the Systems Block.

### **We are recruiting tutors to support the delivery of Remote Telephone Consultation Workshops**

These workshops help students develop consultation and safety-netting skills in a safe, supportive setting, building on learning from Years 1–3 and increasing confidence with remote consultation during their GP placement and OOH attachments. Based on real GP consultations, tutors role-play a scenario to a group of c4 students and then rotate to another group. This is repeated 4 times. Each student leads one consultation and observes and feeds back on three

peers. Students first discuss the scenario for five minutes using available resources, then complete a ten-minute camera-off role-play consultation covering history, management, and safety-netting, followed by a five-minute debrief where feedback is given and key learning points agreed.
