To stand in
solidarity.
To say 'these are
our neighbours'



Detaining people can take place
when people turn up for routine
meetings at immigration
reporting centres, and in dawn
raids (usually taking place
between 6am to 8am). If you see
any immigration vans contact
your neighbours and friends -
you can support your friends
and stop this happening. Video
and share, offer to contact their
friends and lawyer (which
Immigration Officers will try to
restrict access to).

hostile environment,
organise and raise
awareness
