Monday 13th June

8.21am Travel on the **West Highland Line** from Glasgow **to Mallaig** – *'the world's most scenic railway'*

2.00pm Take CaledonianMac's **Ferry** to **Sleat Peninsula** 'over the sea to Skye', then travel across the island to hotel.

Over dinner, readings about Skye from the works of *Robert Burns* and *James Boswell*.



Activities include:

Drive to Woolf's own first port of call, Castle Dunvegan, for tour of gardens, Castle and Boat Ride.

Literary lunch at Greshornish House with 'Scenes from 'To the Lighthouse'
Walk on the coral beach, opportunity for creative writing, walk to Neist Point – dramatic setting and a lighthouse. Duntulm Castle and Skye Museum of Island Life.
Drive or walk in the spectacular Cuillins: "oh, the far Cuillins are puttin' love on me!"
Return either on coach (dep. Portree Square at 3.20pm, arr.Glasgow 10.10pm) (or earlier dep.) or on 3.00pm ferry from Armadale to Mallaig to catch 16.05 train (arr.Glasgow 21.29)

Please note that costs include travel, B+B accom. and entry fees. Lunch and dinner is at your own expense. Weds. night is booked at Sligachan Hotel at the foot of the Cuillins.
