Frequently solicited information:

- 1. All attendees must pay the registration fee.

 Presenters comprise a majority of the conference attendees and are required to pay Standard or Postgraduate / Unwaged Registration fee in full.

 Academic conferences are not for-profit ventures; our budget is limited and we are keeping costs to the absolute minimum possible. The registration fee covers basic catering (coffee, tea, continental breakfasts, and evening receptions, wifi access, pack and bag), printing the programme, office supplies, and the meagre hourly wage for the technical assistants and janitors. Conference attendees underwrite the programme. At the end of the day, our hope is to break even. This is the norm for academic conferences.
- 2. Postgraduate / Unwaged Registration. The reduced registration fee is for people on limited incomes only (e.g. graduate students, the unemployed, and retirees). Academic conferences are not for-profit ventures; our budget is limited and we are keeping costs to the absolute minimum possible.
- 3. For non-presenting attendees only: we will have onsite one-day registration for £70 Standard, and £40 Postgraduate / Unwaged. Payment for this will have to be by cash or cheque/check. We do not have the ability to take credit/debit card payments on site.
- **4. The travel fund.** If you are applying for travel monies, please indicate this on your registration form. Then, as the form instructs, please send a brief email to woolf@glasgow.ac.uk indicating why you need the funds (i.e. your institution is not paying for any travel and you're a graduate student) and how far you're traveling from. Grant amounts are unlikely to cover the full cost of travel.
