Great Women's 10k Glasgow – Sunday 5th June 2016

The Great Women's 10k Glasgow will take place in the west-end on Sunday 5th June with a start time of 10:30am. The event has thousands of participants and is a great opportunity for the city's women to raise some much-needed cash for Scotland's charities. To create a safe and enjoyable race course, The Great Run Company and Glasgow Life have worked closely with Glasgow City Council Roads to minimise the impact of the race on the city, however it is likely that there will be some disruption. This letter is intended to provide clear information regarding how the event will affect your area.

The following road closures and parking restrictions will directly affect your area:

Road Closures

The following road closures and parking restrictions will directly affect your area:

- Gibson Street between Kelvin Way and Eldon Street will be closed from 09:30 to 12:00
- A one-way contra flow system will operate eastwards along Woodlands Road from the mini roundabout at Eldon St & Park Avenue, eastward to the junction of West End Park Street. This will be in operation from 09:30 to 12:00
- Sauchiehall Street west of Kelvingrove Street will be closed from 10:00 to 14:30
- Argyle Street from Sauchiehall Street eastwards to Bunhouse Road will be closed 10:00 to 12:30
- No parking will be permitted anywhere on closed roads for the duration of the closures. Please note that any vehicles parked within the restricted areas will be removed by Parking Services contractors.
- Warning signage and 'No Parking' cones will clearly define these areas.
- The Great Women's 10K will start on Kelvin Way at 10:30 on Sunday 5th June. Runners will be crossing the finishing line at Kelvingrove Street from 11:00am until 13:00. Why not get involved at www.greatrun.org or come along and support the thousands of women taking part?

Parking Restrictions will be in place in your area on the following roads:

- Gibson Street, Eldon Street, Woodlands Road, Park Drive – Sunday 5th June 00:01 until 14:00
- Kelvin Way, Argyll street, Clayslaps Road, Radnor Street, Bunhouse Road, Old Dumbarton Road, Ferry Road, Benalder Street, Sauchiehall Street – Sunday 5th June 00:01 until 18:00

We would be grateful if you would take note of these restrictions and cooperate with the parking restrictions during this time, within these areas. Signs and parking cones indicating the temporary parking restrictions will be displayed in these locations to assist motorists. To try and minimise additional cars parking in the area, we encourage all race participants to use public transport to and from the event through the provision of free subway and shuttle bus services. The Council's Parking Enforcement Unit will be patrolling these streets and any vehicles parked illegally will be removed.

Bus services will be diverted due to road closures and passengers are advised to check their relevant bus stop for information in the week leading up to the event.

Emergency Service vehicles will not be affected by any of the restrictions.
