There have been some exciting developments for the BeST? Services Trial in Glasgow in the past few months that we would like to share with all of you.

Firstly, a massive **thank you** to all the parents, foster families, social workers and other professionals involved in the trial for your continued support and participation. With the first leg of the trial (the feasibility phase) coming to an end on **October 31**<sup>st</sup> we are extremely grateful that we have the support of so many of you going forward into the main trial in November. We currently have **150 families** in the study and are delighted to say over **100 families** are halfway through the assessment process; and over 50 have completed their final assessment.

We have an upcoming dissemination **conference on Friday 28<sup>th</sup> August** with **Professor Charley Zeanah** as our keynote speaker. This is a fantastic opportunity to learn more about the feasibility trial.

We also have a **New Research In Education Conference** coming up on **Monday 5**<sup>th</sup> **October** with fantastic presentations by researchers in the area of child development and education.
