Elliot Napier is the elected SRC Age Equality Officer and is now in his third year in this role. In this time he has been involved in projects such as the creation of the SRC's dedicated welfare team during Freshers' Week, improving facilities for students who are parents, and is currently part of a working group preparing a Parents' Policy. In previous years, he has been elected to sit on Library Committee and Student Support and Development Committee.

Before becoming a student, Elliot served as a police officer in Edinburgh for six years and as a volunteer special constable for three years before that. He spent the past academic year studying at Tver State University, north of Moscow. In his spare time Elliot enjoys travelling, cooking and running. He was a founder member of the Glasgow University Eurovision Society and served as its co-president in his second year.
