PROJECT PROGRESS

- Multiplex started on the Learning & Teaching site in October 2017 following the demolition of the Maths and Stats Building.
- Supply chain partners Bachy Soletanche have piled a contiguous wall alongside University Gardens.
- Careys are preparing the ground-works for the concrete frame, which will consist of three concrete cores.
- 77 piles are complete out of 135 in total, at depths of up to 11 metres.

PLANNED WORKS

- The contiguous wall piles are being capped with a concrete beam alongside University Gardens to support the Learning & Teaching Hub structure.
- We will create a piling mat on the lower level of site which the piling rig sits on. This is done using material from the higher level. Bachy Soletanche will then commence piling the lower level starting adjacent to the Boyd Orr Building.


