

RECYCLING

CUTTING OUR CARBON FOOTPRINT



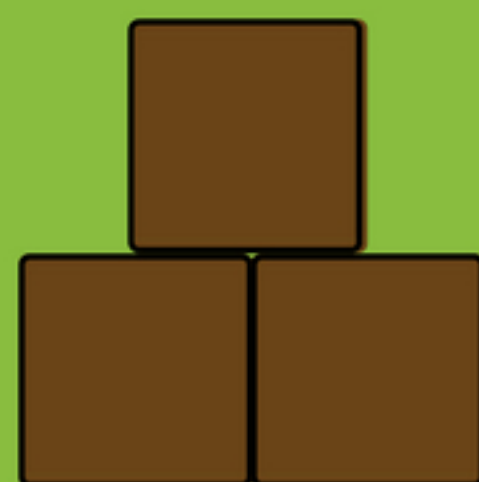
All polystyrene boxes (labels removed) and polystyrene racks should be put in the polystyrene recycling bin on the ramp of the GBRC car park

Brown bottles should be left in fume hoods (lid off) for 24 hours to allow residual solvent to evaporate. They can then be rinsed and put in the glass recycling bin on the ramp of the GBRC car park. The lids can be placed in normal recycling



Glove boxes, paper, plastic/paper wrapping, uncontaminated plastics and media bottles (label scored out) can be placed in the lab recycling bins

Cardboard boxes should be flattened and placed in the box in front of the goods lift on each floor



Unfortunately blue roll, tissues and contaminated waste cannot be recycled
