

Boost in Big C bid

SCIENTISTS have discovered key differences between adult and childhood leukaemia.

The breakthrough could help develop specific treatments for the different forms of the disease.

Researchers from Glasgow Uni studied acute myeloid leukaemia – one of the most aggressive types of the cancer.

Dr Karen Keeshan said: “The disease in children is distinct from the disease in adults.

“By identifying targetable features, we can use new treatment strategies.”
