# Directions to the 2 main meeting hotels

# 1. Grange Strathmore

<u>Address</u>: 41 Queen's Gate Gardens, Kensington, London SW7 5NB, UK <u>Phone</u>: +44 20 7584 0512

The Grange Strathmore Hotel is located minutes from South Kensington and Gloucester Road underground stations, both are served by the Piccadilly (Blue) line which connects Heathrow Airport Terminal 1-5 to the city centre. This is the easiest and fastest way of getting to the city centre from this main London airport and tickets can be purchased directly from the automated machines next to the platform entrance.

There are fast and frequent trains between Gatwick Airport and London. Gatwick airport is served by four different trainlines. Gatwick Express offers a non-stop rail service between the South Terminal and Victoria Train Station (served by the Circle and District lines) in central London. Trains run every 15 minutes and take around 30 minutes. This is the fastest and the most expensive way of getting to the city centre from this airport. Other train services to London Victoria are available and the journey time is 40 minutes at least.

You can buy tickets for any rail service at the station or the rail ticket desk in the Onward Travel area in Gatwick South Terminal.

Nearest Underground stations are highlighted in yellow.



# 2. Bailey's Hotel Gloucester Road

<u>Address</u>: 140 Gloucester Rd, South Kensington, London SW7 4QH, UK <u>Phone</u>: +44 20 7373 6000 The hotel is located directly opposite Gloucester Road Underground Station (Circle, District and Piccadilly lines), which is connected to Heathrow Airport Terminal 1-5 by the Piccadilly Line. This is the easiest and fastest way of getting to the city centre from this main London airport and tickets can be purchased directly from the automated machines next to the platform entrance.

### Directions to the meeting venue from the hotels

Both hotels are conveniently located within a short walking distance to the nearest campus entrance, Queen's Gate entrance (left-hand side of the map), as well as within 5 minutes of walk from the Gloucester Road and South Kensington Underground stations (Circle, District and Piccadilly Lines)

# South Kensington Highlights

South Kensington is home to a cluster of free museums, making it the perfect destination for families and adults alike.

At the Victoria and Albert Museum, you can see art and design from the past 3000 years, including ceramics, furniture, fashion, jewellery, photographs, sculpture, textiles and paintings. Just next door you'll find London's Natural History Museum, where you can come face-to-face with a giant T-rex, and experience an earthquake in the Power Within zone.

There's plenty of green space in South Kensington – the area's home to two of London's magnificent Royal Parks, Kensington Gardens and Hyde Park.

When you're in Kensington Gardens, make sure you visit Kensington Palace, the current London residence of the Duke and Duchess of Cambridge. It is also where both Queen Victoria and Diana, Princess of Wales lived. Explore the State Apartments, see Queen Victoria's bedroom, look around temporary exhibitions, stroll around the landscaped gardens and enjoy a delicious afternoon tea in the Orangery.

Take a walk around Kensington's Royal Parks and you'll discover lots more attractions, including the Serpentine lake, the Albert Memorial, the Serpentine Gallery, and the Diana, Princess of Wales Memorial Playground.
