- 6. Oversee and manage the direction, development and improvement of the research programme infrastructure and facilities by guiding the input of University colleagues, external collaborators and industrial partners.
- 7. Contribute specialist lectures and seminars to undergraduate and postgraduate students in the relevant and related subject areas, in accordance with the Institute/School/College programme.
- 8. Where appropriate, participate fully in assessment and examination processes using a variety of methods and provide feedback to students that is relevant, timely and supports their learning.
- 9. Where appropriate, seek out and deliver knowledge exchange opportunities aligned with research programme and Institute objectives.
- 10. Perform administrative tasks related to the activities of the research group and School, including Budgets/Expenditure.
- 11. Perform administrative tasks related to the activities of the project and Institute, including budgets/expenditure.

- 12. Engage in personal, professional and career development, to enhance both specialist and transferable skills in accordance with desired career trajectory.
- 13. Undertake any other reasonable duties as required by the Head of School/Director of Research Institute.
- 14. Contribute to the enhancement of the University's international profile in line with the University Strategy, <u>World Changing Glasgow 2025</u>.
