

Researchers to examine Chinese response to virus

A TEAM of researchers is to examine the response of the Chinese government to the coronavirus outbreak.

Led by Professor Jane Duckett of Glasgow University, the team will assess the measures put in place in China to combat the virus, which originated in the city of Wuhan.

The study will look over policy documents from the

government, as well as Chinese social media and field work in four areas of China – Beijing, Guangdong, Hubei province where Wuhan is located and the neighbouring Anhui province.

The team of 12 researchers includes one from Peking University, along with six from Glasgow and another from Manchester Metropolitan University.
