Students need a minimum of 3 A-levels (first sitting) to meet the general entry requirements for most degrees at the University of Glasgow. This information sheet outlines which A-level subjects are specifically required for different degrees. Accountancy & Finance	Mathematics, (GCSE English).
MA Arts degrees (e.g. Ancient History, Archaeology, Celtic Civilisation/Studies, Classics, Comparative Literature, Digital Media & Information Studies, English Language & Linguistics, English Literature, Film & Television Studies, French, Gaelic, Geography, German, Greek, History, History of Art, Italian, Latin, Music, Philosophy, Portuguese, Russian, Scottish History, Scottish Literature, Spanish, Theatre Studies, Theology & Religious Studies)	Must include at least one Arts, Humanities* or Language subject. MA Music – A-level Music or ABRSM Grade 5 Theory is required.
Dentistry	Biology & Chemistry. Some A-levels not accepted.
Engineering degrees	Mathematics and Physics (or Technology & Design, either Product Design or 3D).
Law	English (or GCSE English Lit & Lang)
Medicine	Chemistry & one of Biology, Mathematics or Physics. Biology at AS level if not studied at A-level. Some A-levels not accepted.

BMus Music	Music or ABRSM Grade 5 Theory. Merit in Grade 8 ABRSM practical exams.
Nursing	Two from Biology (or Human Biology), Chemistry, Mathematics, Physics.

Psychology	Subject requirements change depending on whether this degree is studied as MA, MA (SocSci), or BSc Hons. Please see <u>www.glasgow.ac.uk/undergraduate/degrees</u> for specific requirements.

Veterinary Medicine	Biology and Chemistry. A science subject is preferred as third subject. Some A-levels not accepted.
