Due to the current COVID-19 pandemic, we are running a reduced schedule for the VLN technical Workshop (<u>www.ukvln.net</u>), with the aim of delivering a full event late in the year, subject to the health situation improving.

This workshop is a chance for students and researchers to present their work on a wide range of related subject areas, and for researchers and industry to meet and discuss rotorcraft technology.
