

LAST YEARS PLANS- INTRAMURAL/ GUSA DODGEBALL/GU SPORTS DAY

Having spent a year being an intramural house Vice Captain and a member of the current GUSA Events team, following this year's success, I want to continue to improve the **intramural league**. If elected, the preparations for the next term's intramural league will start in the summer. The house captains and the teams will be chosen before the new academic year, so the league can hit the ground running in September. A **GUSA dodgeball** tournament, along with a **GU Sports Day** are a couple ideas from last year that I want to put in the works. In the sports day, the clubs and intramural teams would be mixed into new teams and they would play against each other throughout the whole day. One of my priorities next year would be to establish these events and encourage members to try different sports as well as promote friendly competition between clubs.

ROUNDERS CUP

Rounders had the most participants in the intramural league. It was a great way for everyone to engage with sport during the pandemic. Next year, I would like to establish a **rounders cup**, and have the 4 intramural houses compete over a series of games. It would run over the course of one semester and there would be a final at the end of each semester. A rounders cup would bring the intramural houses together and give a chance to people that are not part of GUSA to compete.

Finally, I think inclusion is very important and it is fundamental for all the clubs to know that their ideas will be heard. There are 51 affiliated clubs, and if elected I will have meetings with as many of the new club committees as possible. Furthermore, I will create an **Events Best Practice Guide** for clubs to run their own events that will be explaining everything from booking unions to managing events teams. It would build the relationships between all the clubs in GUSA and provide opportunity for new ideas to be heard by GUSA council. My year in volleyball CTS has made me want to strive to work on making every club committee feel respected and heard when wanting to propose event ideas that without the support of the whole union they wouldn't be feasible.
