1. Working Paper Series

| Description | Woking papers provide a more detailed discussion on a topic or issue. They can be based on preliminary results, technical papers, or literature reviews |

| Word count | 20,000 words |
| Number of figures, tables, boxes, or graphs | Max. 5 |
| Abstract | 300 words |
| Key messages | key messages should be outlined in bullet points |
| References | At least 5 |

2. Research Report/Policy Brief Series

| Description | Research reports should be based on published research or forthcoming journal articles. Policy briefs should describe the scope of the issue and present the practical implications of the research (i.e. what the research says about the problem), as well as propose concrete steps stakeholders should take. |

| Word count | 3,200 words |
| Number of figures, tables, boxes, or graphs | Max. 2 |
| Summary | Not required |
| Key messages | key messages from the research should be outlined in bullet points |
| References | Max. 10 |

Please write the title of your manuscript at the top of the first page, followed by the names of all authors and their affiliation in the order they should appear. Section headings should be numbered. If you would like to include logos or images, please send them as separate files. These can be in PNG, JPEG or pdf formats. Please ensure that you proofread your document prior to submission.
