### How will the posters be judged?

Poems will be judged on:

- Creativity appeal to the senses and help the judges 'experience' your school through your poem
- Content try to focus on a few key aspects rather than trying to cover everything
- Catholic—make sure you highlight the faith dimension of your school!
- Communication is it well-presented and communicated in an engaging way?

There will be **two winners** in each age category and the winning poems will be posted on *The Cloisters* blog.
