

We would like to announce the <u>Cosmo 2022 - Scotland workshop</u>, a continuation of the previous four events known as the Nordic Workshop on Cosmogenic Nuclides. The three-day workshop and the oneday field excursion will be jointly hosted by the Scottish Universities Environmental Research Centre (SUERC) and the University of Edinburgh, and held in **Edinburgh**, **7-9** June 2022. The workshop will comprise a scientific programme of oral and poster contributions by members of the international cosmogenic nuclide community, discussions, short practical workshops, and an optional field excursion the last day.
