Cancer screening can save lives.



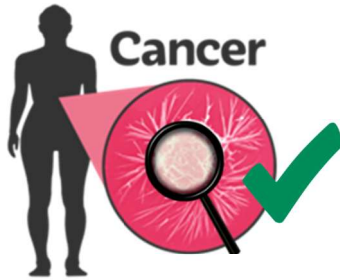
There are 3 types of cancer screening people do in the UK: breast, cervical, and bowel.

We also want to know what stops people getting cancer screening.



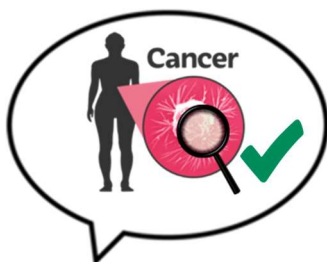
This can tell us how to help more people with learning disabilities get screened.



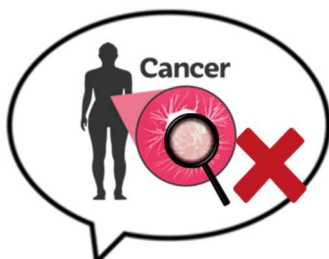
What do we want to do?

We also want to talk to carers who care for someone who has been invited to get screening.



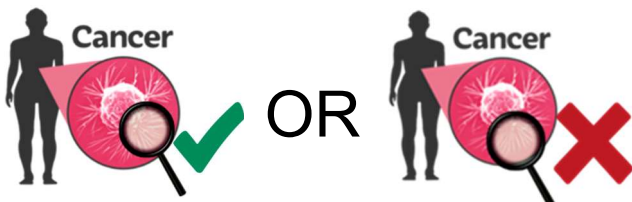
