REACH-HFpEF Trial: 14 centres across England, Scotland, and Wales now open!



We're well on our way to hitting our target of 20 sites open by the end of the year....

How are we doing so far?

As of 7th October, you have screened 205 individuals and randomised 21 with 14 pending (initiated & baseline in progress).



Lessons learned so far?

Our screen to randomise ratio is 5.9 to1. This is very consistent with our previous REACH-HF multicentre trial in HFrEf patients (5.4 screened to 1 randomised)/REACH-HF pilot trial in HFpEF patients (4.5 to 1).

Primary reason for trial non-entry is not meeting the i/e criteria – looking at the screening data in more detail, this is due to a mix of specific clinical factors i.e., not having LVEF ≥45%, not meeting NT-ProBNP cutoff, no HF admission in last 12 months, contraindications to exercise training, possible alternative diagnosis (e.g., COPD), and prior LVEF <45%. Second largest reason for exclusion are patients who meet the i/e criteria and decline participation.

REACH-HFpEF TOP TIPS #2

When screening patients, make sure to emphasise REACH-HF is a COMPHEN-SIVE rehabilitation programme (and not exercise only) that includes education and psychological support with the aims of improving their patient overall quality of life and their HF self-management

Have a copy of the manual(s) to show patients (and caregivers) when you meet to screen/discuss trial entry
