# **Charles Haviland, BBC journalist**



Charles Haviland is an international news journalist at the BBC. Up to 2014 he spent 12 years based in Asia as a correspondent, living in and reporting from Sri Lanka, Nepal, Afghanistan, India and Pakistan and seeking to convey stories of war and peace, human achievement and tragedy, society, culture, economy and more. His work has also taken him to Latin America, North America, South-East Asia and Africa. His current work sees him editing and writing news output for the BBC World Service; his earliest BBC duties saw him tackling news from the USSR, then still in existence and doing

its best to liberalise in contrast to the trajectory of today's Russia. He belongs chiefly to both London and central Scotland and still loves, above all, to travel and explore.
