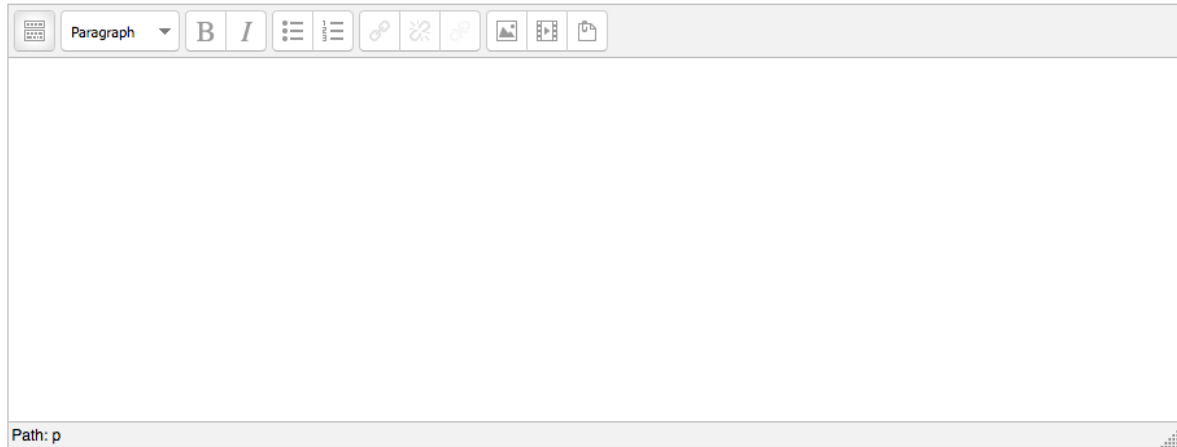


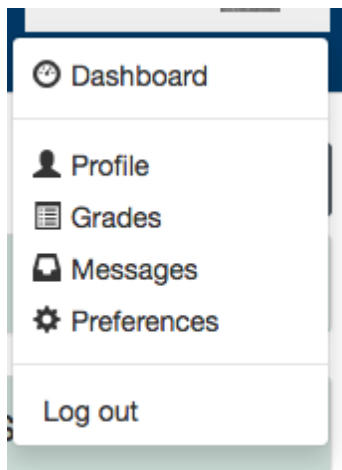
Changing your editor in Moodle

The editor toolbar in Moodle that controls the formatting of text can be changed in Moodle.


